

Notes: The CT result at 22 cm was surprising. An ECT would not break at 22 cm until we hit the shovel several times with a drop kick. South of Provo Canyon and/or at higher elevations, the layer of facets at the ground is thicker. Very low density snow on surface would sluff very easy.
