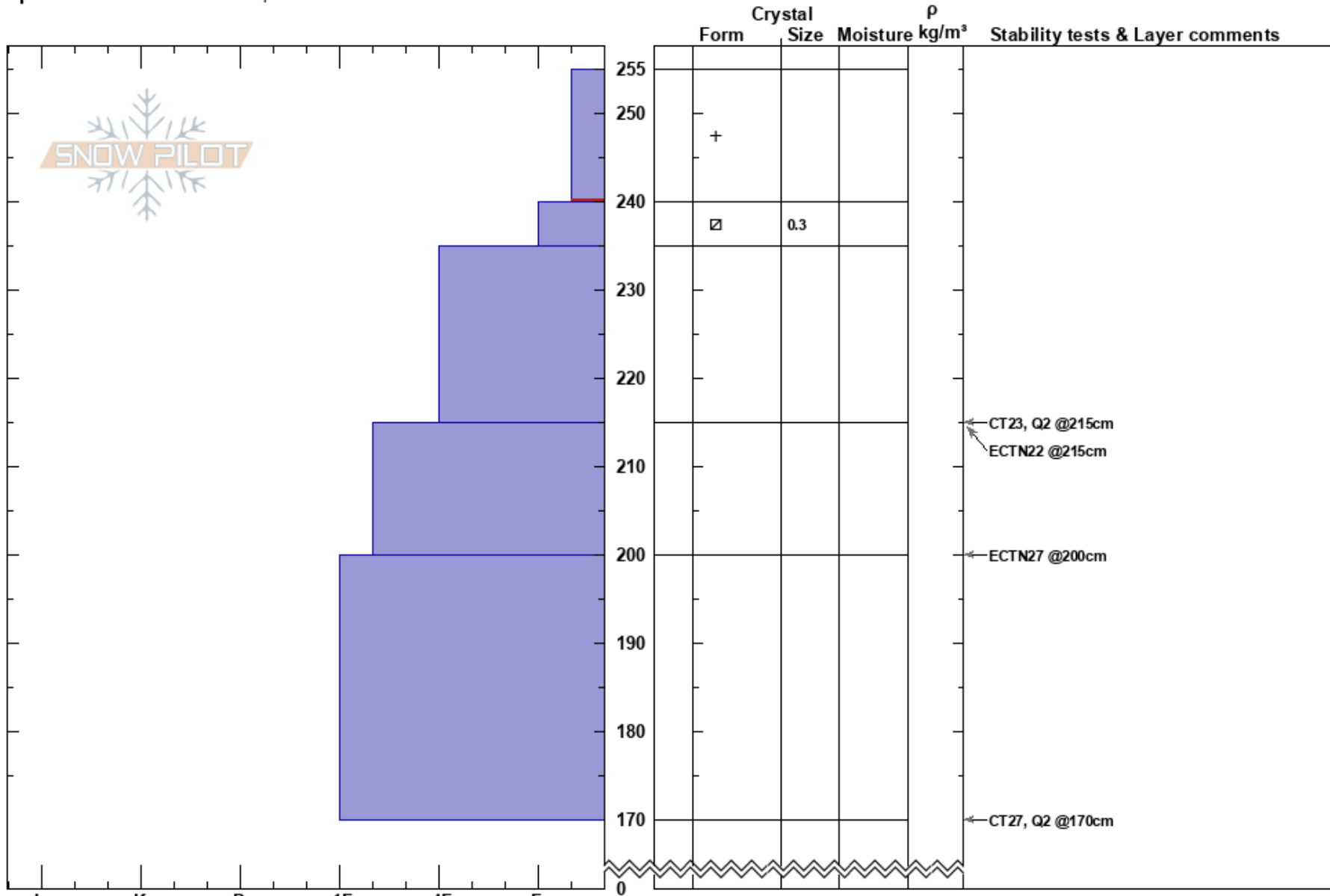

When we got above treeline in an area with just a little wind, the new snow sluffed very easy and ran far distances. More snow and more wind overnight will mean more dry loose avalanches and sensitive wind slai
