

Notes: East aspects are gaining strength with increased HS and mild temps over the last couple weeks. Continue to see rounding facets near the ground. Nice trend hopeful to see continue. Found facets below a crust buried 20cm below the surface. Likely Radiation Recrystallization, my favorite, elusive weak layer. Did not propagate but it is something to keep an eye on.
