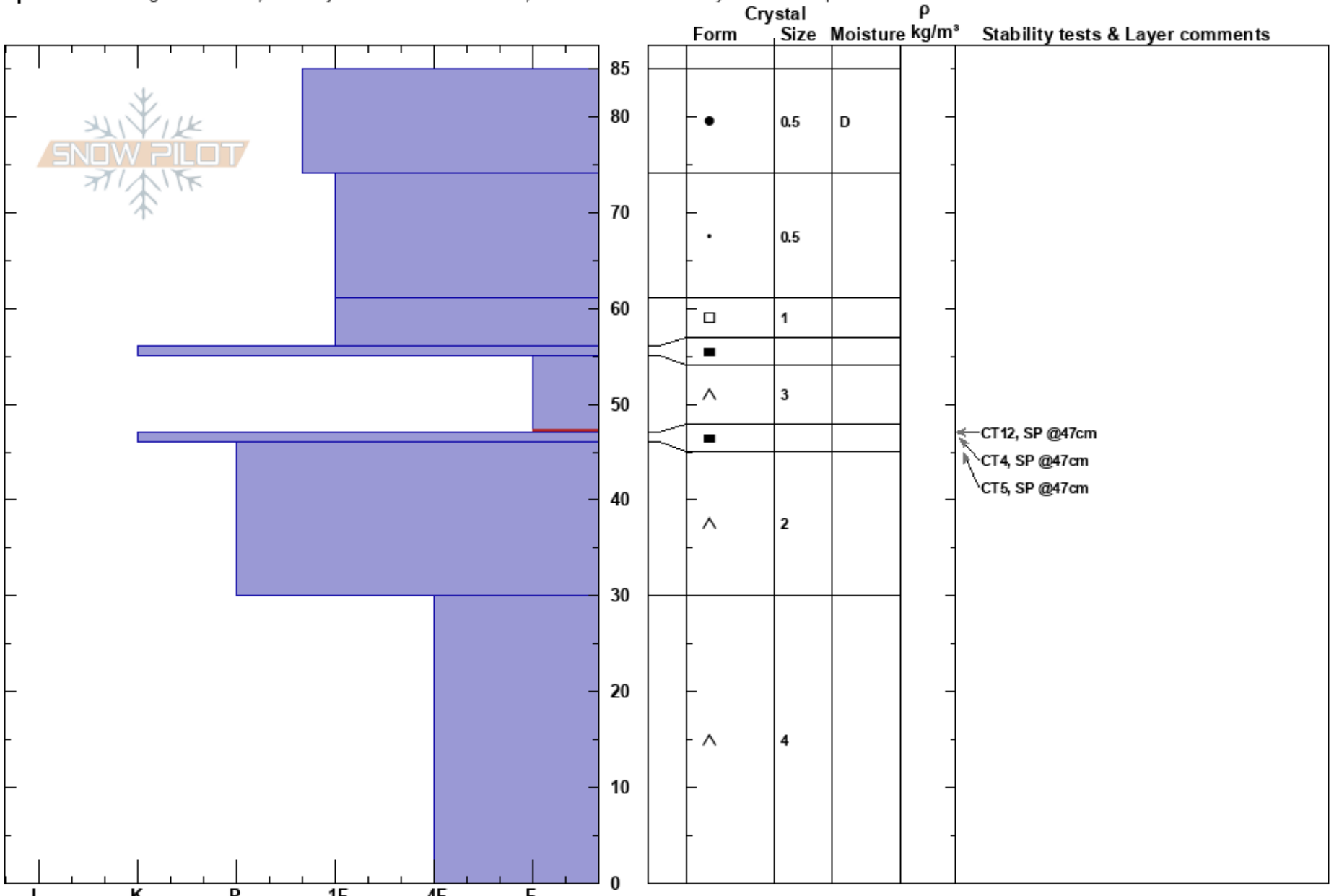

Notes: Avalanche failed on 3mm striated facets above the October ice crust. thin coverage where the avalanche initiated in shallow snow near the ridge top with a crown height of 30 to 60 cms deep fully entraining the snow throughout the path up to 1.5m possibly deeper to cone level. Damaged trees and rocks throughout the debris.
