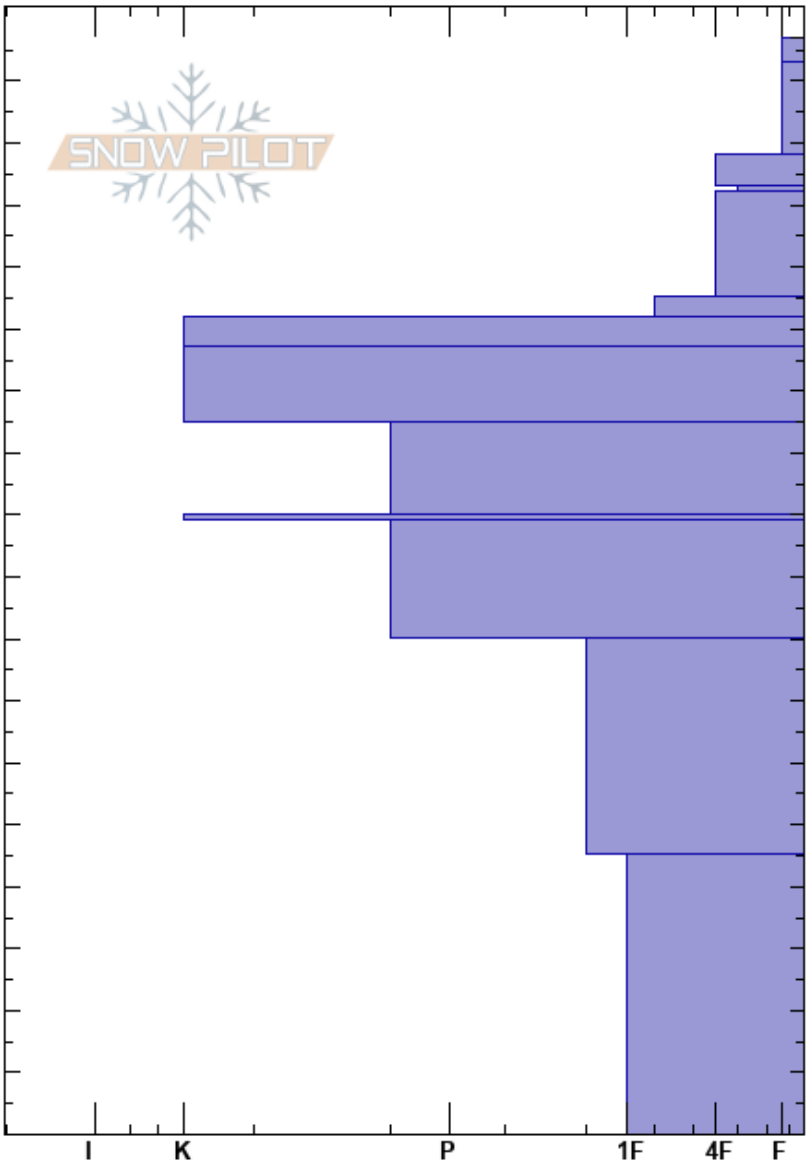

Rounding moist facets still exist from 80cm and below but it would take a huge load to break the K hard crusts above. Or another significant warm up.
