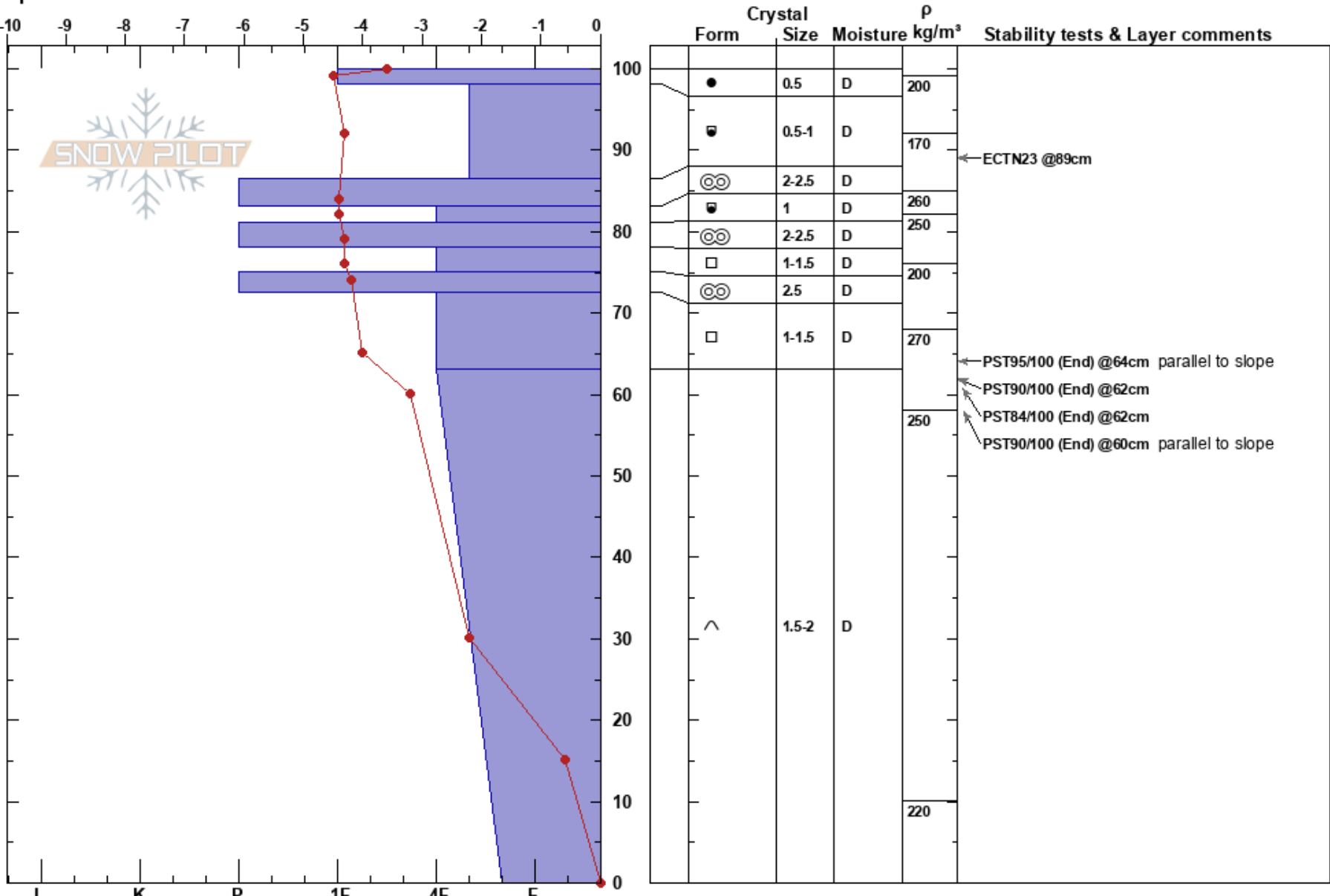

Notes: Ski penetration: 5 cm. Pit dug near main Beehive basin skin track as well as below a smaller skin track. When "parallel to slope" is in notes for stability test it means that the column was isolated with the long side running parallel to the dip of the slope as opposed to perpendicular to the dip (standard PST column).
