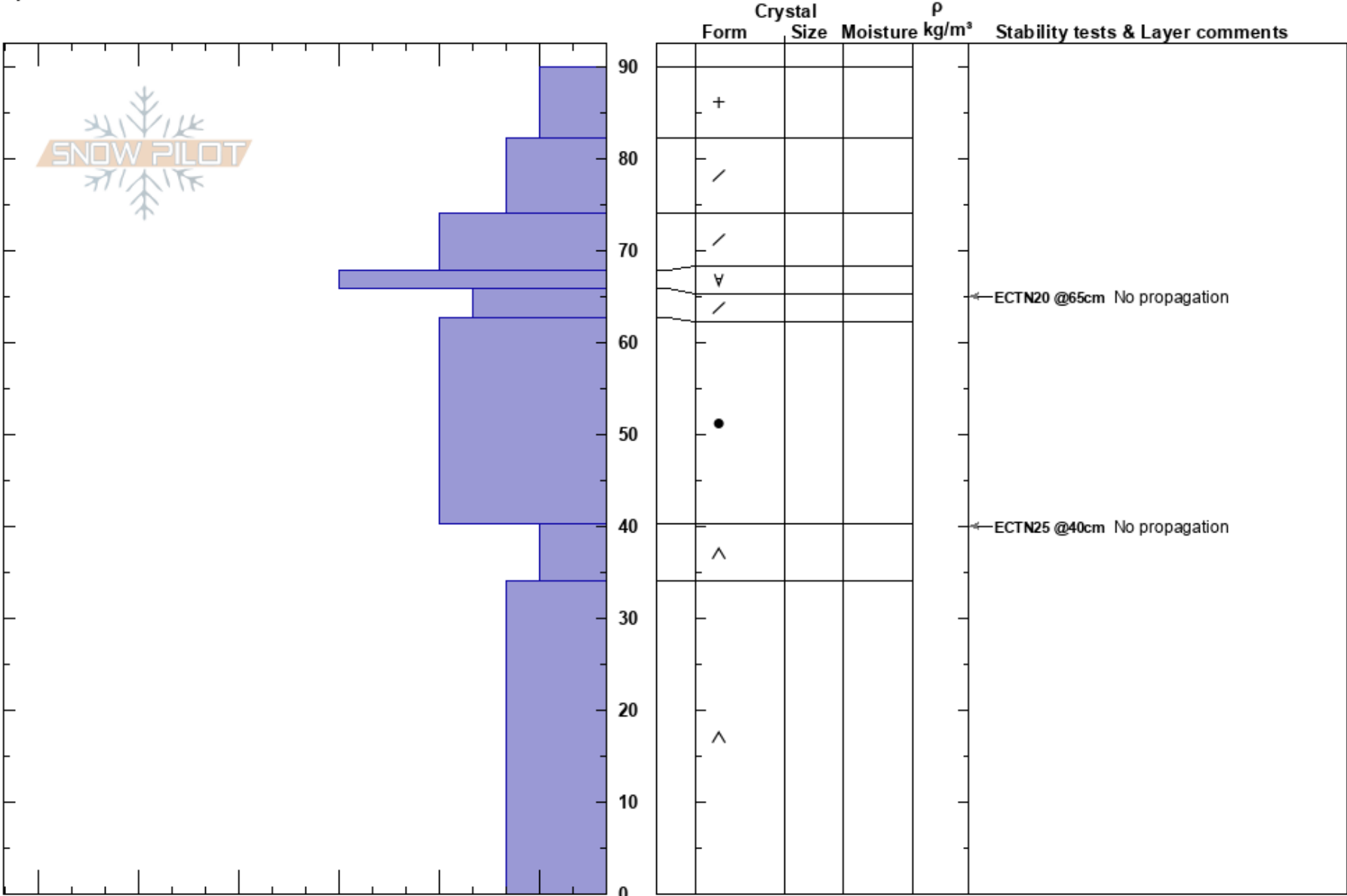

Notes: Location is down in bowl in a relatively thicker snowpack that had some previous wind deposits. You sink to the ground in depth hoar on foot. Most of the snowpack is 40-50 cm deep but this was deeper, which was probably why it was not propagating on ECT. Experienced localized collapses on shallower snowpack areas.
