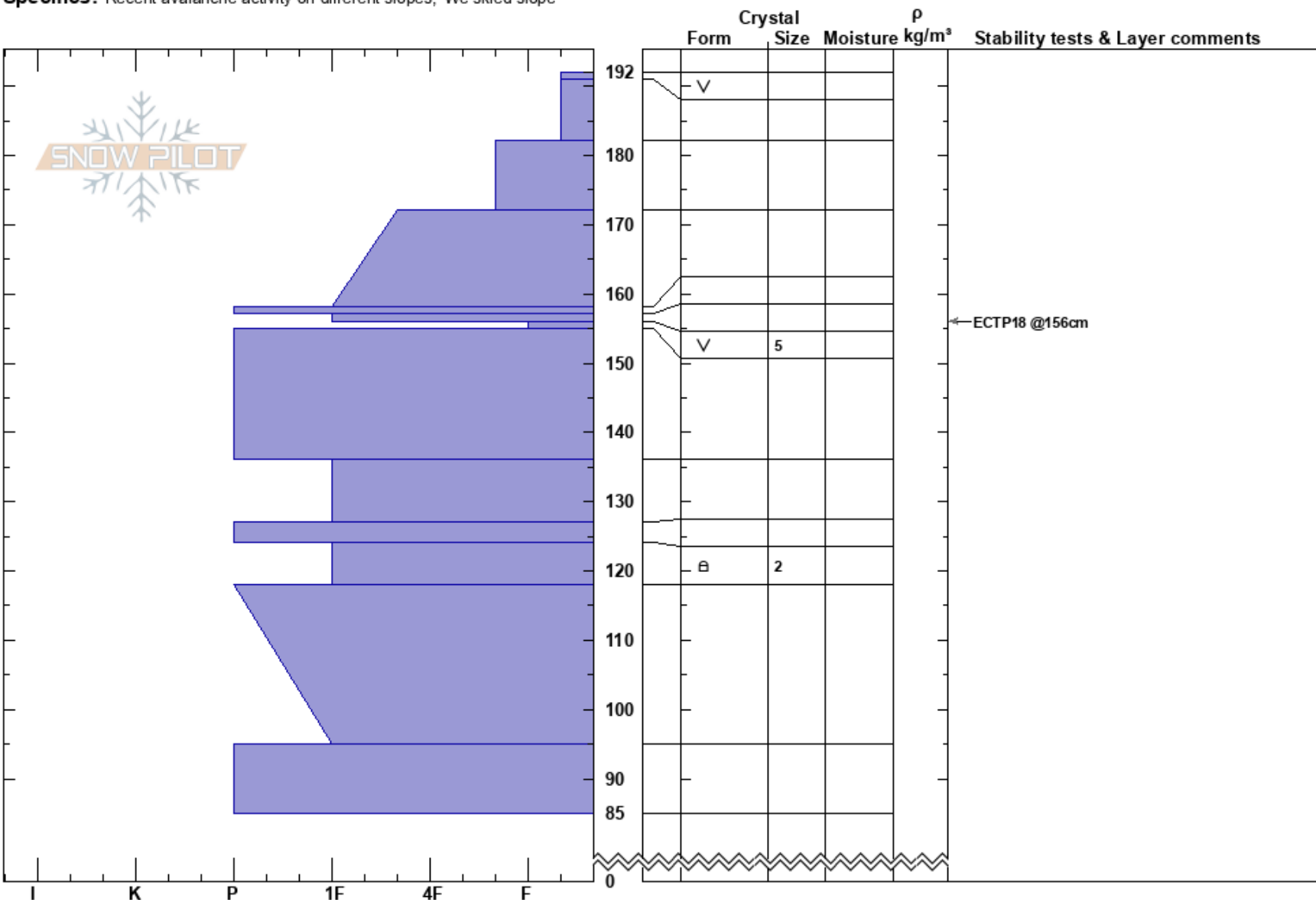

Notes: Also found the same buried SH layer on a nearby east aspect (CTM Q1).

No collapsing while breaking trail for part of the afternoon.

There were also some fresh (3 days old?) slab avalanches nearby, on a steep, rocky SW aspect of Meridian Peak, that appeared to be triggered by a mountain goat.

And, observed some fresh point releases (from the last 24/48 hrs), which were entraining a fair bit of snow in sustained steep terrain.
