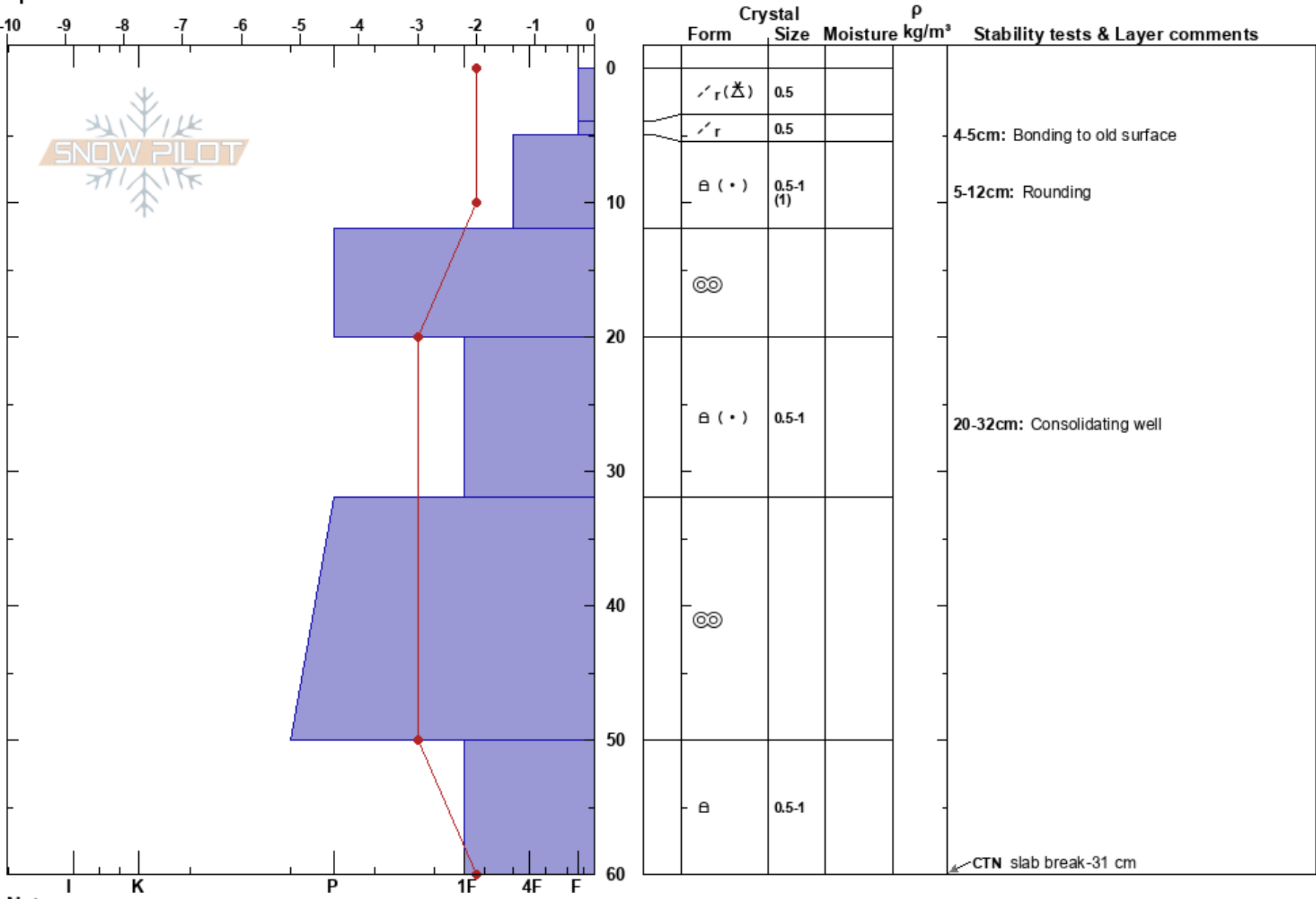

Notes: Recent warm spring temps have significantly rounded grains on N aspects. Crusts have thickened as well from warming diurnal cycles. Only smooth shear was within 5 cm of new snow, which is bonding to pre-storm surface layers (crusts included on sunny aspects). Rough shear (slab break) in main layer between the two main crusts.
