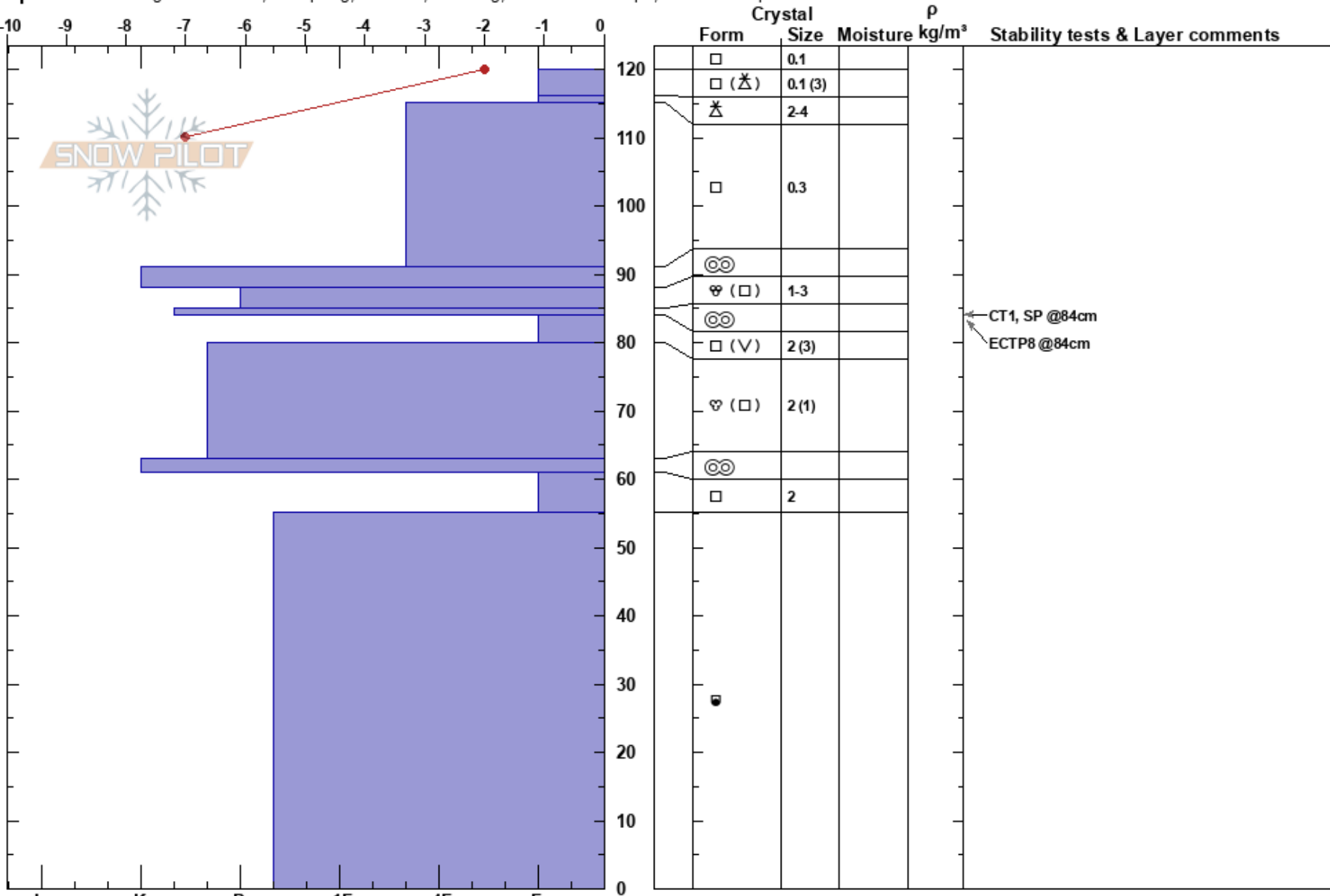

Specifics: Pit dug in a Ski Area; Collapsing, localized; Cracking; Ski tracks on slope; We skied slope



Notes: Dug in upper High Noon above the roadcut, experienced multiple collapses and shooting cracks on the slope on entrance and exit but no avalanches. All breaking on the same layer of facets and old surface hoar 36cm down, consistent with test results. There was less snow on the surface below the roadcut and we did not experience any cracking or collapsing there. Dug by MR and DW.
