

Notes: Overall, the snowpack in this area was generally uniform. Weak sugary snow existed on top as the area was mostly shaded and protected of the warm sun the last few days, and well formed facets of varying size were found throughout. Two interesting layers of approximately pencil hardness were found relatively close together approximately mid way through the snowpack.
