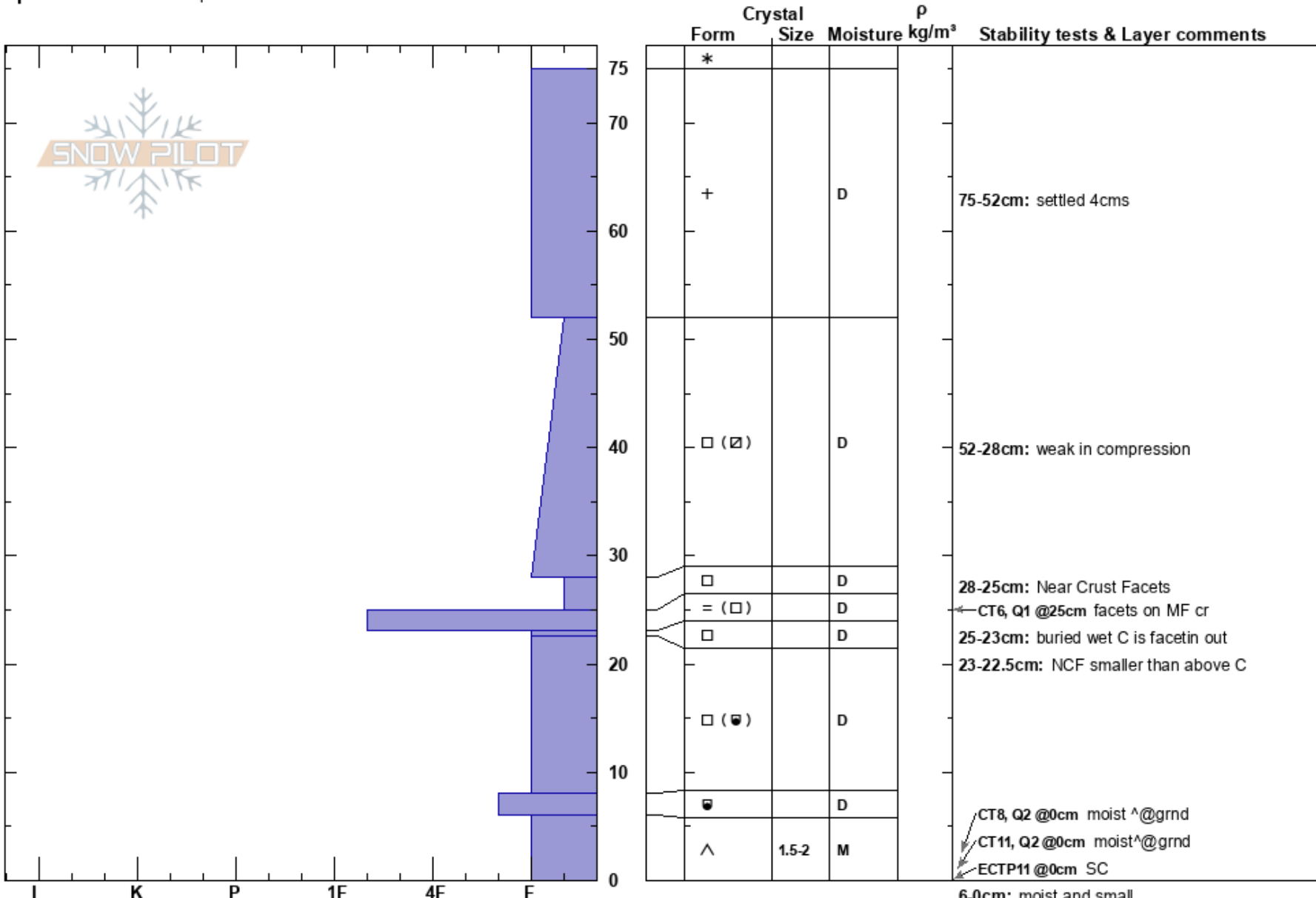

Notes: Lots of pluming at peaks and ridge crests. NNW aspects in Summit were raked, stripped and boney during the night and early AM hrs. Particularly CO, Summit and Gilpatrick -11C @ 1400/1100h until 1430 when 20 mph NNW winds began to effect elevations below 3000' Then temps increased to -6.5C by 1630h . Additional Layer Comments: 0-6cm: moist and small ; 0-6cm: Problematic layer;
