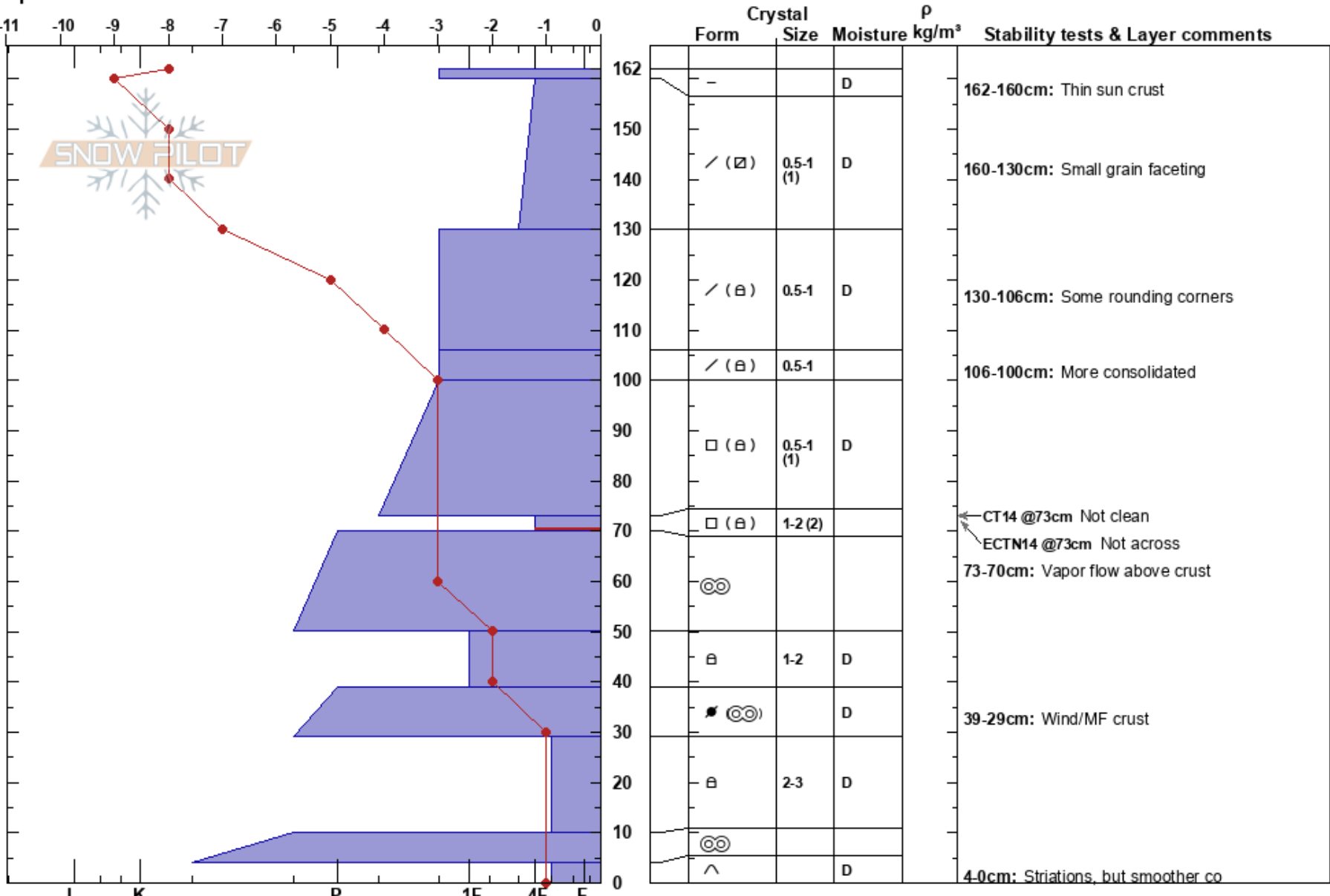

**Notes:** Much settlement from recent storm has consolidated snow pack, and made shears harder to elicit than a few days ago. Relatively weaker snow around old crusts, but no clean Q1 shears were elicited. Additional Layer Comments: 70-73cm: Problematic layer; 29-39cm: Wind/MF crust; 0-4cm: Striations, but smoother co;
