

Notes: West facing and solars aspects stayed dry till just about 330 or 4pm. Still good skiing on solars. Temperatures show a healing snowpack and test results verify in this location. One collapse lower in the flats on a shaded aspect earlier in the morning. Melting surface hoar and NSF mixed with broken PP on surface. Clear skies and cold temps previous night.
