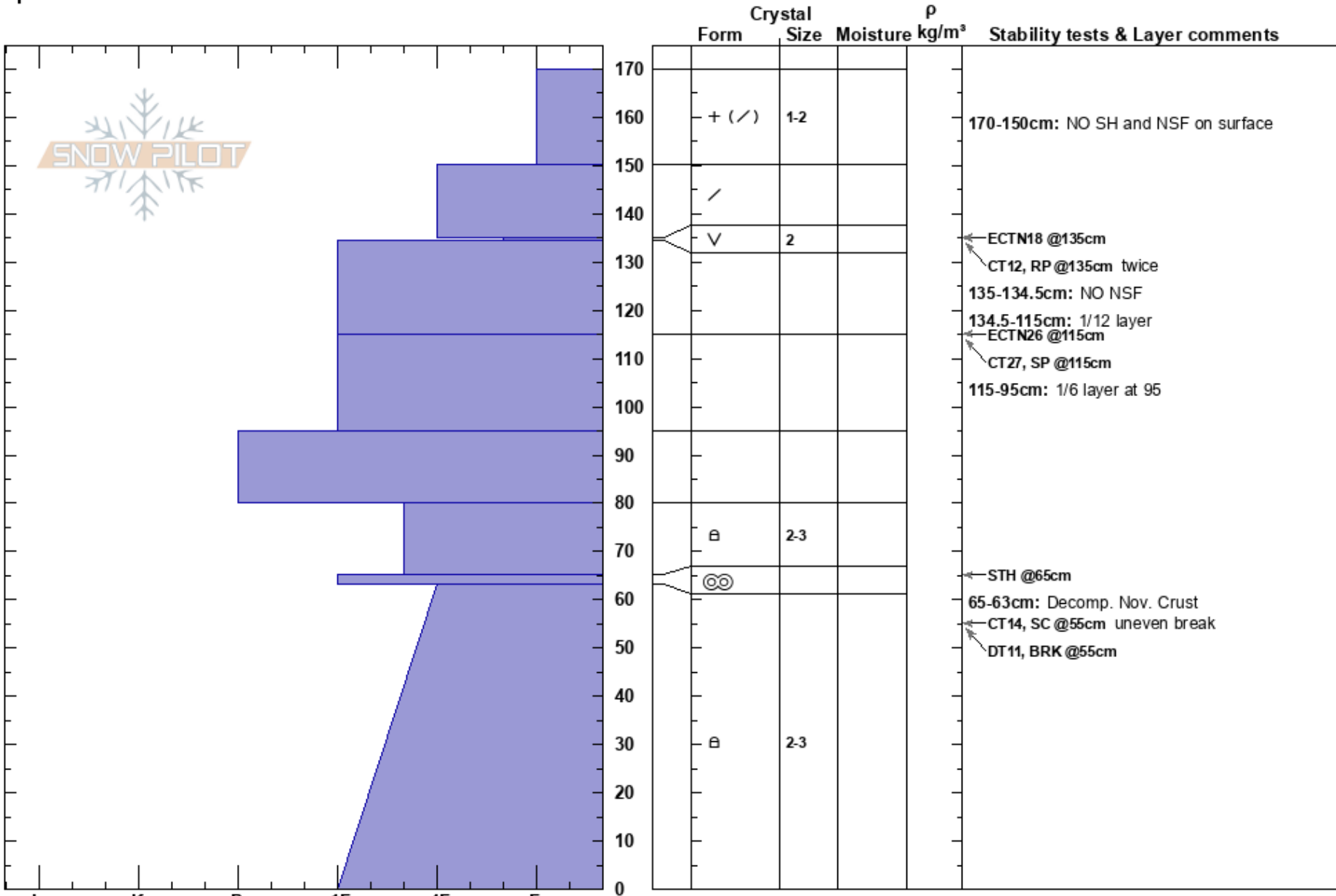

**Notes:** 2110 meters. Pit dug to assess buried surface hoar layers and November facets. Buried surface hoar layers from 1/22, 1/12, and 1/6 did not propagate a fracture, nor did the November crust facet combo. The 1/22 SH and November Facets were reactive in small block tests and Deep Tap. Layers are seemingly healing... slowly. No collapsing, cracking or reaction to skiing on slopes to 35 degrees. SS-Ny-R2-D2-O initiated by loose snow hitting debris fan causing a small wind slab with step down to PWL 1/3 way down apron. Likely triggered within 48 hours on Dorval Peak out of prominent East Couloir.
