

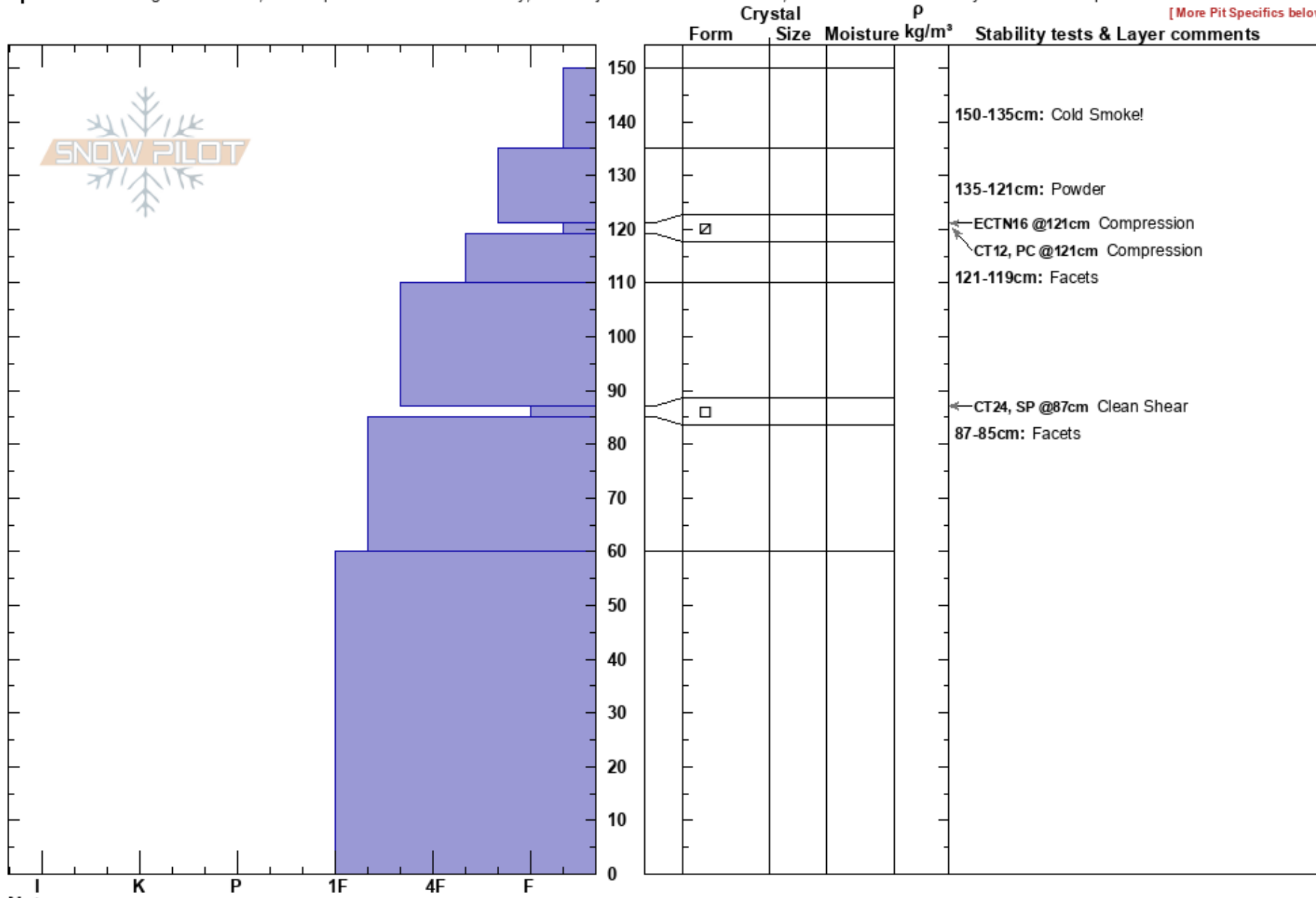

**Notes:** Dug 150 CM Pit; Total Snow Pack was approx 195-200 CM.

Adjacent avalanche (SS-N-D2-O/S) ran for approx 100 yards (estimated). Appears to be fresh from previous day's heavy snowfall. Guessing it failed on Old Snow surface approx 20-30 cm down. Slide path was on substantially steeper terrain than test area. Additional Pit Specifics: We skied slope
