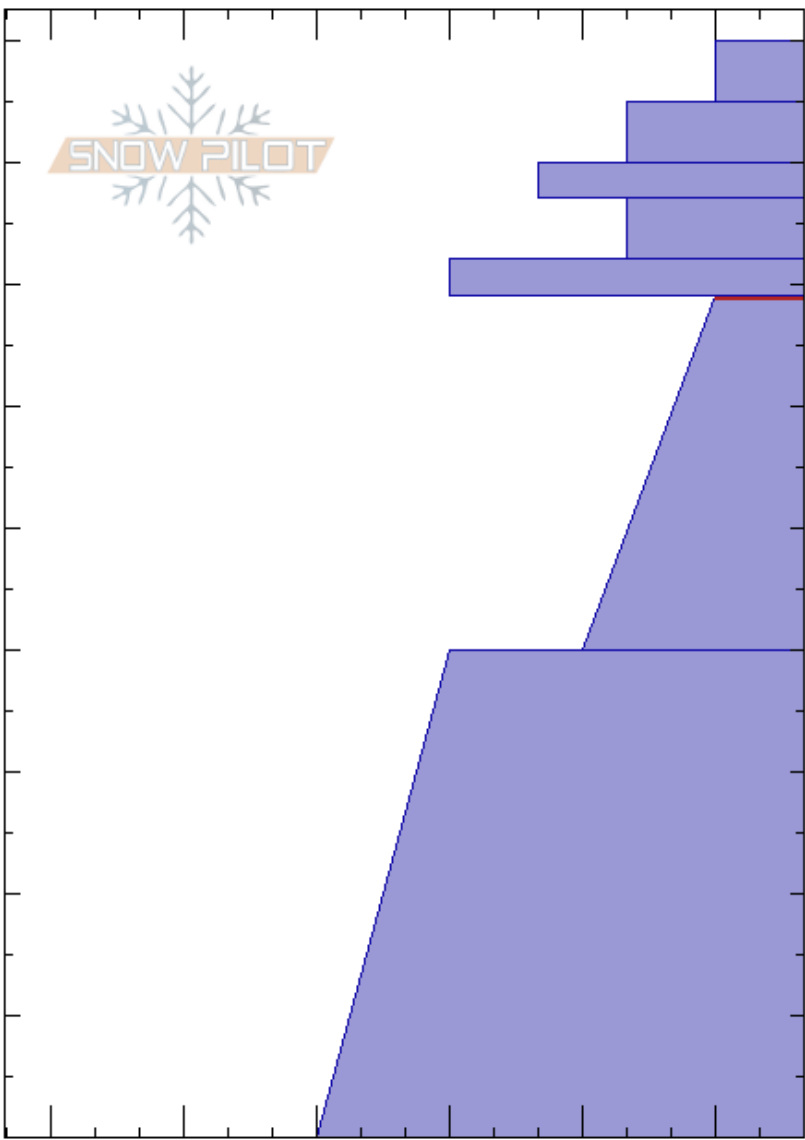

**Notes:** Winds ranged from strong SW (in the canyon) E (mouth of the canyon) SE ( 7,000' ridgetops). Snowpack was mushy. North facing at 7,000' was 120cm with wet faceted snow on the ground in North Willow. South and southwest facing slopes at this elevation had patchy snow. No Precipitation at 1300 and pouring rain up to 7,000' upon exit at 1600.
