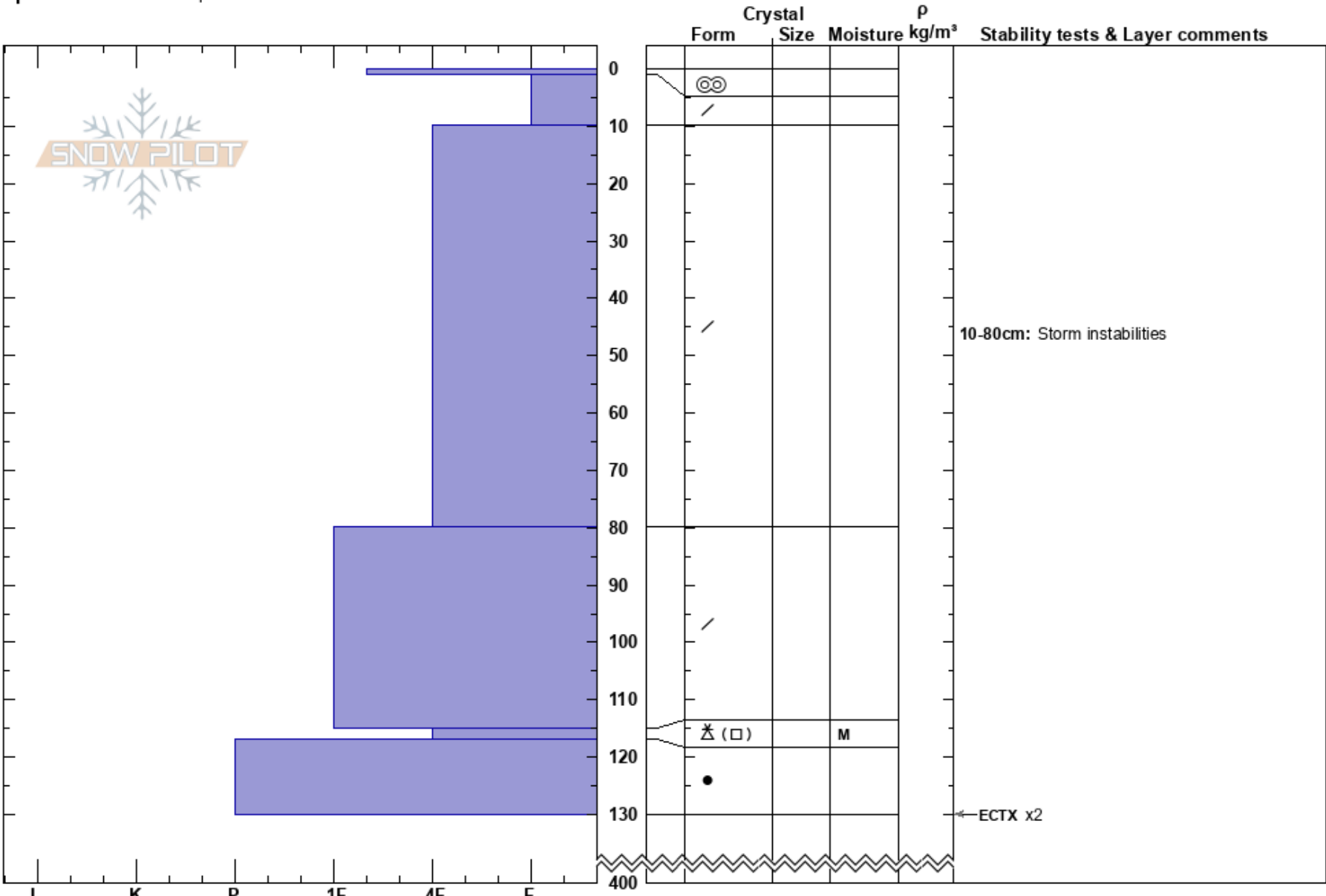

Notes: ECTN results in the top 2' of the snowpack. These will settle out over time. Overall ECTX with failure on faceted graupel layer above a pencil hard rounded grains with propagation x2 after ECTX with a hard shovel pry. I would be surprised if this layer was the culprit in further avalanches.
