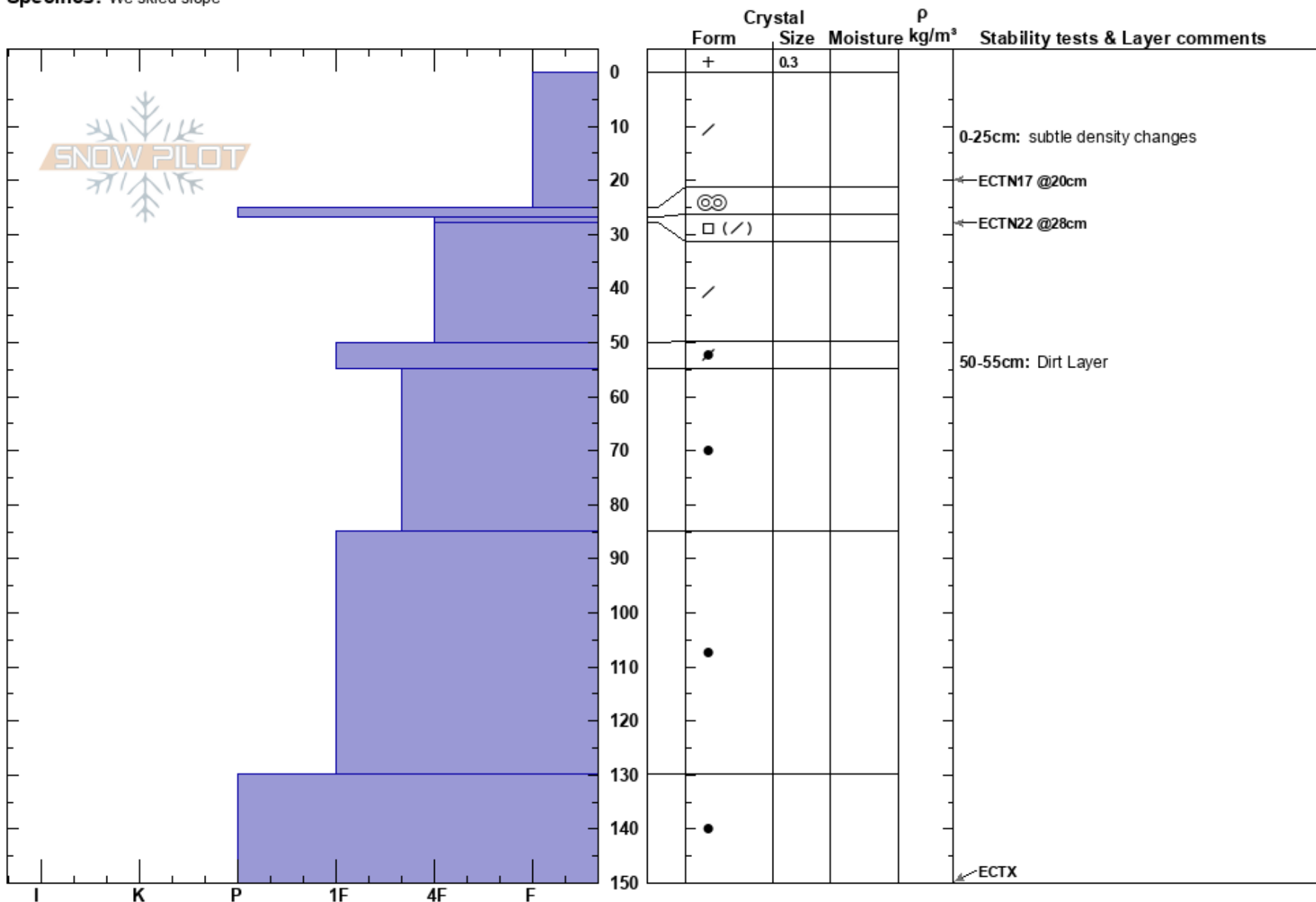

**Notes:** Thin crust 10" below the surface from warmup the other day. This crust had small grained facets underneath the crust and broken stellars above the crust. The new snow was bonding well to the crust. In this location there was no melt-freeze crust associated with the dirt layer.
