

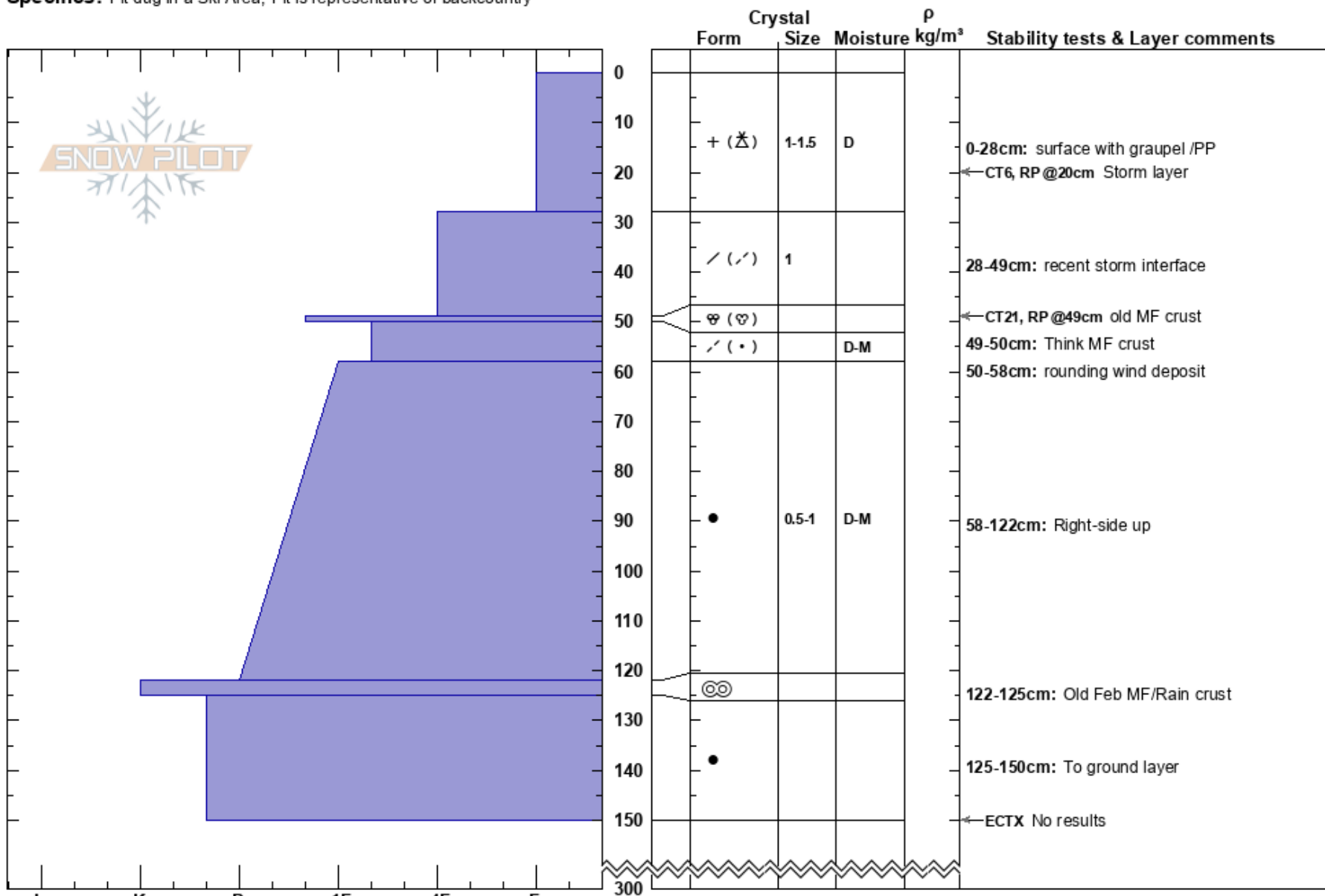

Found a very thin crust on steep shaded slopes with snowpack generally right-side up to ground. . Additional Layer Comments: 122-58cm: Right-side up ; 125-122cm: Old Feb MF/Rain crust; 150-125cm: To ground layer;
