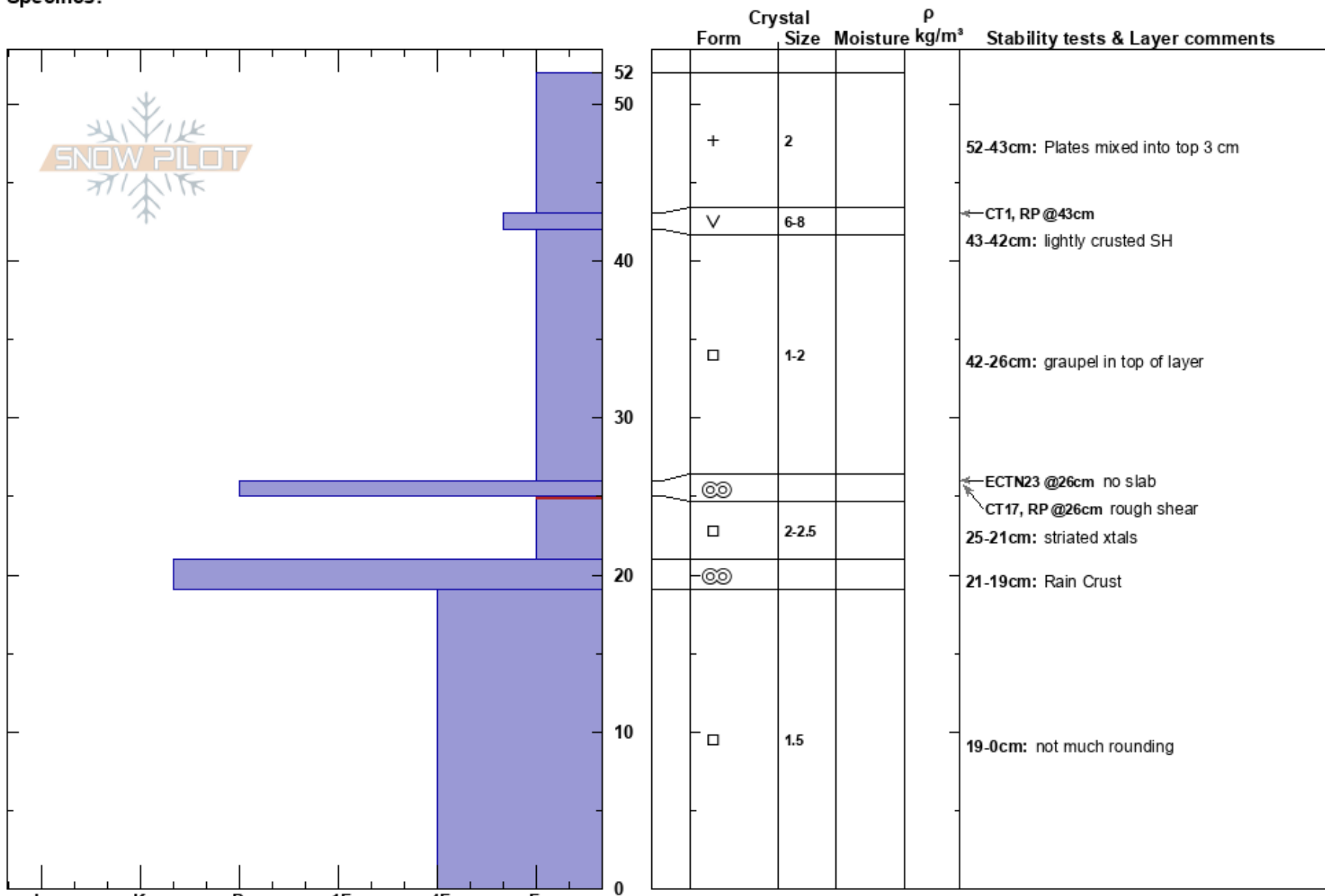

Notes: Annual Thanksgiving Day Pit in the same location as previous years. Far skier's left side above KB Ridge. Floating average since 1986 is just under 83cm for this area. Snowfall and winds were increasing through the morning and the surface snow was starting to slab a bit. No Whumpfs or shooting cracks observed. General HS at 9K was 20-30cm with 50-55cm on the north aspects.. Additional Layer Comments: 19-21cm: Rain Crust; 0-19cm: not much rounding;
