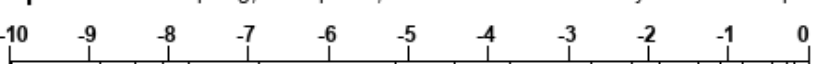

Notes: Widespread collapsing in the area. Remote triggered a D2.5 a couple hundred yards away from this pit location about an hour later on NE slope. Broke in steep rocky terrain at convex rollover. A good amount of moisture in the snowpack including the facets under the new slab. You could almost make a snowball.
