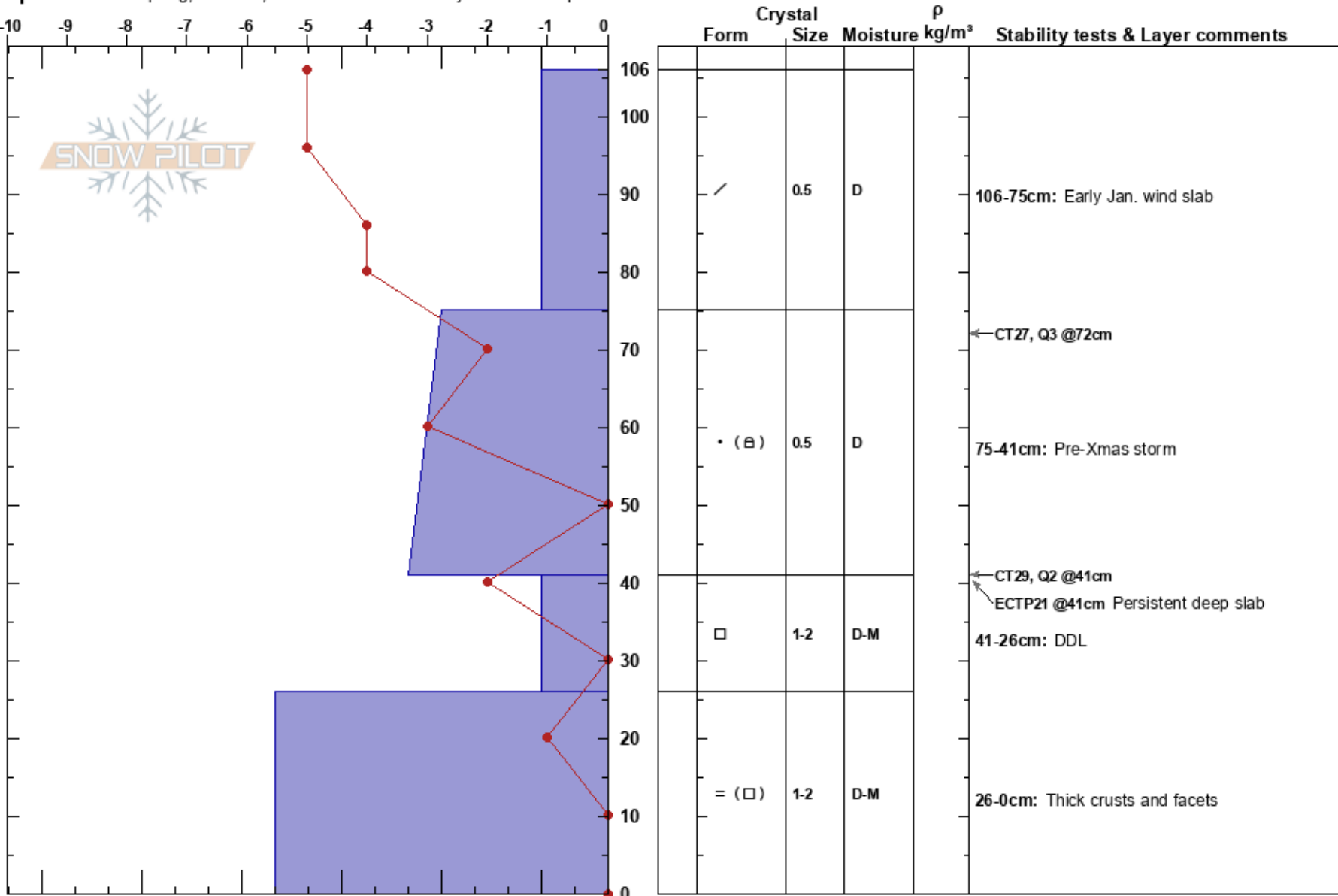

Notes: Whomping (collapse) upon taking off skis. Facets very well-developed at this location and may persist as a PWL and part of our avalanche problem for the rest of January at mid elevations and lower high elevations. Widespread surface hoar development (3-6 mm).
