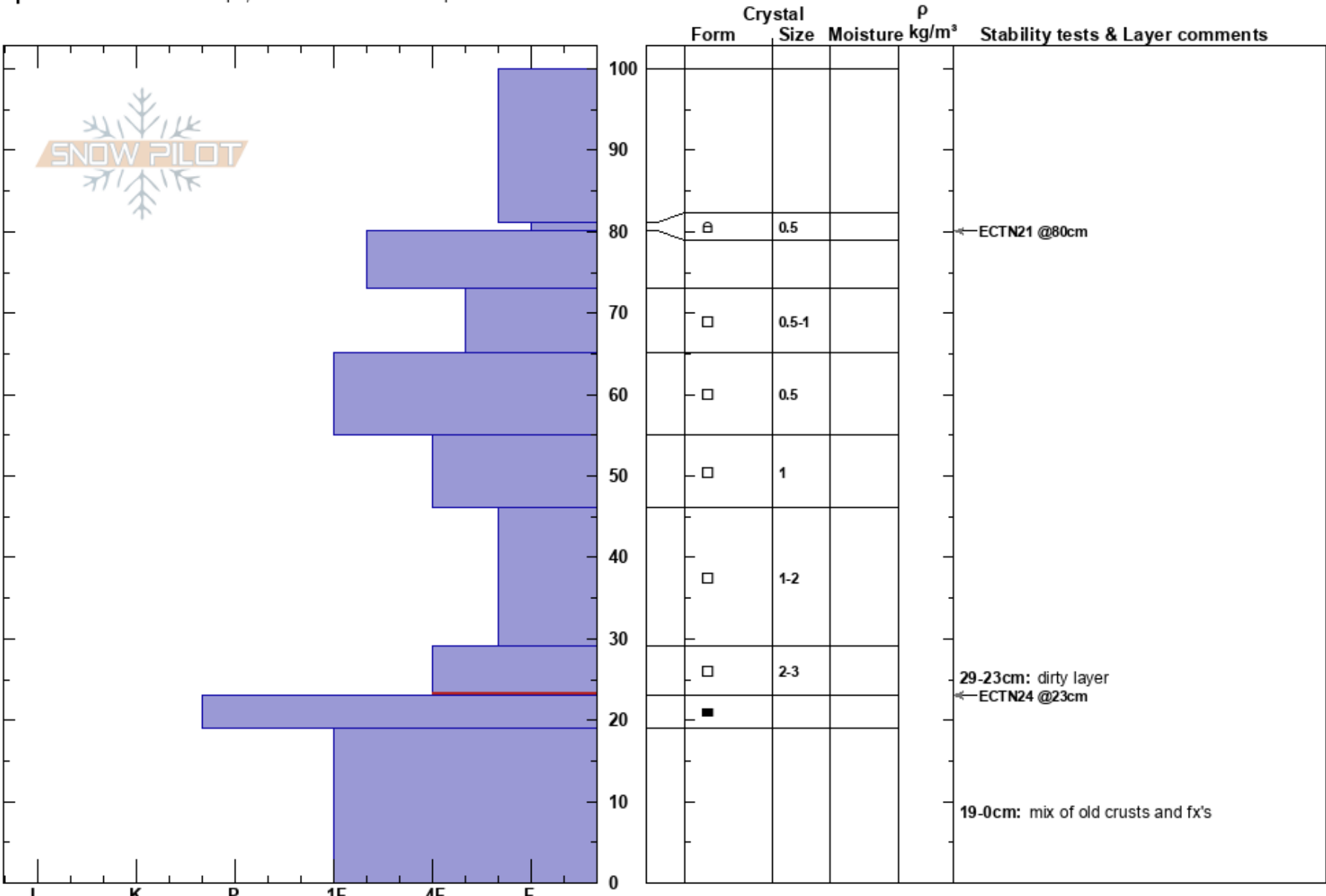

With the right load, it will find the right layer to make an avalanche, but today was the first where I saw a glimmer of hope for our snowpack.
